- Original research, systematic reviews, meta-analyses, case studies, and perspectives are welcome.
- Submissions should be submitted via the following [SUBMISSION LINK](#) by July 31st, 2024.

Review Process: All submissions will undergo a peer-review process conducted by experts in the field. We encourage high-quality contributions that advance our understanding of the social determinants affecting ear, nose, and throat, head and neck health.

Publication: Accepted manuscripts will be published in the fourth issue of the ORL – Head and Neck Nursing Journal in 2024, reaching a global audience of healthcare professionals, researchers, and educators.

Peer Review Period: August 1st- September 30th, 2024

Expected Publication Date: November 2024
